		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Every member of the playing and managerial support staff will be provided with Board and COVID-19 Officer contact details for advice or support.</li> <li>• Every member of the playing and managerial support staff must follow guidance posters and email updates whilst at the club and most importantly when visiting opposing teams.</li> <li>• Whilst changing prior to games the management and support staff will be in separate dressing room and when possible, face coverings should be worn and as little time as possible spent in the changing facilities.</li> <li>• During matches and training sessions players must avoid touching the ball with their hands/sharing equipment/goal celebrations, making social distancing the highest priority throughout.</li> <li>• Players and staff are encouraged where possible to use personal water bottles at training and during games. If this is not possible players should only use the club individually named bottles.</li> <li>• Post and pre match food will only be available in 'take away' form where players and staff will collect food when called by pavilion volunteers and then they must eat the food off site to avoid social contact and potential spread of the virus.</li> <li>• First Aid facilities will still be available to all players and officials in line with FA medical guidance before during and after games or training.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Changing room doors and windows must always be left open to provide appropriate ventilation and reduce the risk of spread.</li> <li>• Pitch side Volunteers will decontaminate balls in breaks of play and Coaching staff will facilitate equipment allocation and decontamination during and at the end of training sessions and warm-ups.</li> <li>• All club water bottles will be marked with individual names and decontaminated after games and training sessions.</li> </ul>	Board/LG	Ongoing	completed
